Optional activities (extra cost)

Flying Fox \$20

The **Flying Fox** is a thrilling 80 metres long. Participants climb up staples on the tree to a high platform and transfer to the flying fox then zip along a cable and come to rest in the middle of the cable from where there is a long lower down to the ground.

Vertical Playpen \$17

The **Vertical Playpen** pits two teams against each other to see who can navigate a series of vertical obstacles the fastest and most effectively. The climber is belayed by their team who provide the lift up and lower down. Involving participants to take responsibility for belaying for encouragement and support develops compassion, empathy, communication and cooperation amongst group members. This activity fosters group cohesion and team accomplishment.

The Tower of Tremble \$17

Two climbers are supported on belay by their team members to create a trembling tower of crates. Working together the team passes up crates to the climbers who are building the tower as the team lifts the climbers up.

The Tower of Tremble fosters physical coordination, balance and agility and helps groups to support each other through encouragement and coaching.

Archery \$14

Field Archery Australia Qualified Instructors offer Target Archery at Maranatha. Target Archery is the most commonly practiced form of outdoor archery worldwide with targets 80+ centimetres wide and divided into five colours with each colour divided into two to provide 10 scoring zones. Sophisticated strong and light, recurve bows using aluminium, fibreglass or carbon fibre arrows bring this ancient art into the 21 century. Young archers learn to focus on the target with their dominant eye while using their non-dominant eye to give depth of field. Eye dominance also determines which hand the archer should hold the bow with.

Rocket Ball \$14

Rocket Ball – aim the balls at the target. The giant sling-shots are permanently fixed in the ground
